The A330S light, also known as the Golden Bell, was originally designed for the Savoy Restaurant in Helsinki and was introduced internationally in the Finnish Pavilion at the Paris World Expo. Made from one single piece of brass, the "Golden Bell" combines Alvar Aalto's typical streamlined design with his characteristic manner of diffusing light.
